Enjoy an exclusive tour through the most charming and picturesque of Tuscany's hill towns. Far away from mass tourism, experience authentic cuisine and organic wine and visit the tiny hidden hamlets of Tuscany together with a professional, English-speaking private chauffeur-guide. Your chauffeur will ensure that you are able to catch Tuscany at its most photogenic! Amidst the rolling hills you admire splendid vineyards, olive trees, spring wild flowers, and fruit trees.

Your first stop will be at the amazing Badia a Passignano. Visit the Antinori wine cellar shop where, if it's not too early, it will be possible to taste great organic wine. The Badia is a splendid monastery built originally as a Castle and dating as far back as the 8th century. Your next stop will be the 10th century fortification of Montefioralle, known to be one of the best kept medieval hamlets in Italy. Here you will enjoy a privately guided walk through the cobbled, narrow ring of the Old Town. On to Greve in Chianti, the Capitoline of the Chianti Wine chianti region! Here you will have some free time to visit the many traditional shops on the main square where Tuscans shop for their own homes today. Baskets, belts, furniture, ceramics ... this charming town has it all. Not to be missed here is a visit to the Falorni Butcher shop, where you will be surrounded by a staggering variety of salami and hams, as well as an incredible variety of aging pecorino cheese in the underground cellar dating back to the 1300s.

For lunch you have several options. You may choose to visit a private winery; the owner and sommelier will show you the property and the cellars where you will indulge in a wine tasting of Chianti Riserva and Super-Tuscans, balsamic-vinegar, oil, and vinsanto. Or you may choose a simple trattoria where you will be able to order à la carte from a list of authentic, Tuscan specialties. If you would like something a little more formal we will be very happy to make a reservation for you in a stunning 14th Century castle, where your host will give you tour of the amazing rooms and the local enologist will conduct a wine tasting and suggest a seasonal, annotated lunch.

After lunch a drive through the sunflower fields and green hills will bring you to the medieval town of Castellina in Chianti. Here you will have free time to explore the town and have a coffee out on the sunny piazza. At the end of this unique day, your chauffeur will drive you back to your accommodations in Florence.

Martino Cathedral, the Piazza dell'Anfiteatro and the Guinigi Tower, one of Lucca's most prominent medieval sites. In recent history it is famous as the birthplace of Giacomo Puccini, one of Italy's most famous operatic composers. You may choose to visit the composer's house, now a museum or take a walk on top of the splendid city walls, now a city park ringing the entire town. Your chauffeur will meet you after your tour or walk and together you will travel to Pisa, stopping along the way for an authentic lunch in the Tuscan countryside. Pisa is a unique city, combining the elements of vibrant university town, important Italian port, and cultural gem. Renamed by the poet Gabriele d'Annunzio the "Piazza dei Miracoli" and declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Cathedral Square holds the Duomo, the Campanile (known popularly as the Leaning Tower of Pisa), the Baptistry, and the Camposanto. Your tour guide will show you the highlights of this piazza as well as the city's narrow streets, typical street markets, and the frescoes by Vasari. At the end of the day your chauffeur will take you back to your hotel in Florence.

One of the must-see areas of the Eternal City, now 2,769 years old, the Roman Forum and Colosseum represent the best of what was the ancient city. You will enter the heart of Ancient Rome represented by the civic center of the forums from its pagan roots to Christian times. The Forum and Palatine Hill are enchanting and beautiful places to visit with secrets that do not easily reveal themselves. Your guide will show you how each stone tells a fascinating tale of intrigue and power struggles, murder and ambition while at the same time representing civilization and law, beauty, and religious piety. Our traditions of religious tolerance, law and representative government all came from this hallowed ground.

Built over the Emperor Nero's private lake in order to wipe out any trace of his existence and meet the entertainment demands of a growing population, the Colosseum has been the emblem of Rome for its inhabitants and visitors for nearly 2,000 years. Fifteen stories high, covering 7.5 acres, the power of theater was taken to extremes never seen before as we evoke the truth of its past with a legacy of stories stranger than fiction.

After your visit to this monumental area, you will walk with your guide to the Pantheon, once the Temple to All the Gods and now a Christian church, passing by the Temple Sanctuary in Largo Argentina.

NOTES: We recommend sturdy, comfortable walking shoes as archeological ruins can be uneven and dusty (or muddy!). In warmer weather water bottles are also recommended; fountains with potable water are common throughout the city.

Venture into the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica with your private guide, and uncover some of the world's most amazing masterpieces. *Skip the line with reserved entry tickets*. This tour gives a fascinating in-depth visit to the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica with ample time to appreciate the wealth of sacred and profane history, art and religious works contained within its fortified walls.

You will explore the Vatican City in all of its splendor with a focus on hidden symbols, secrets, myths, and stories along with its poignant great works of art and their history giving you an insider's view that you will never forget. Your visit will begin in the Courtyard of the Pine Cone where you will go back in time to see the pagan masterpieces first installed by forward-thinking, art-loving Popes, and stand in the same spaces where Michelangelo, Raphael, Bernini, and Canova once stood. In the sublime Raphael Rooms, the grand apartments of Pope Julius II, young Raphael's genius is on display. In his dramatic compositions your guide will reveal the hidden clues to the powerful Papal world of the early 1500s. Raphael also pays homage to Michelangelo, who spent ten years working in the Sistine Chapel, where you will view his fresco masterpieces: the Last Judgement, the Sistine Chapel ceiling, and the great devotional paintings of the Tuscan and Umbrian Renaissance masters. Your guide will reveal the meaning of the frescos, their symbolism as well as hidden and often bizarre details, and describe the elaborate and tortured task Michelangelo took on.

In the ethereal Basilica of St. Peter your guide will recount the stories of the popes and artists who brought about its existence, reveal the hidden symbolism in its monuments, and the wonders of its architecture and decoration. Here you will learn the secrets of Michelangelo's first masterpiece, the *Pietà*, and his last, the great dome. Two generations later mathematics and creativity drove Bernini's elaborate plans both inside and outside the Basilica, full of symbolism and drama: Piazza San Pietro and Colonnade, the Cathedra Petri, the Baldacchino, and the Monument to Alexander the VII.
